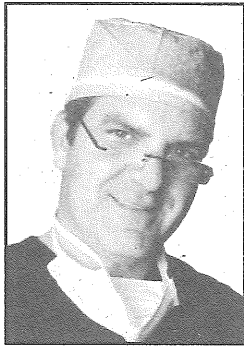


## Local vein expert launches eMedical technology
